Dear Coaches,

Enclosed you will find registration materials for the June 1, 2013 Virginia Open AAU Qualifying Tournament to be held at the Stuart Beville Middle School 4901 Dale Blvd Woodbridge, VA 22193. <http://bevillemsschools.pwcs.edu/> Youth Sports Jump Rope FX will host this event. Any US or Non-US athlete may compete in this event for practice, for fun, or to attempt to qualify through this event for the 2013 AAU Junior Olympic Games in Detroit, MI from July 24<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup>, 2013. We look forward to seeing you on June 1<sup>st</sup> ! Included for your information are directions and hotel details.

Copies of forms should be made as needed. Please note that all team registration forms, individual permission forms, registration fees of \$40 per person and officials' sign-up **forms and fees should be sent to me to be received no later than April 13, 2013** in order for your athletes to be accepted for this competition. Late entrants will be charged an additional \$10 fee and will only be accepted on a space available basis. Checks should be made payable to Youth Sports. The entry fee entitles jumpers to compete in any number of events in their age-group.

**All competitors, coaches, judges and scorers must be registered 2013 AAU members PRIOR TO COMPETITION DAY.** You may sign up online at [www.aausports.org](http://www.aausports.org). AAU cards and proof of age must be available upon request. A confirmed membership number must be obtained and produced. An individual athlete Qualifying Tournament Registration form must be signed as indicated for each participant. There may be an entry limit imposed of 6 entries per team in any Individual Rope or Double Dutch event, with only 1 entry per team allowed in the Junior Group Routine and the Senior Group Routine. The limit will depend on the numbers entered in each event. Female singles 13-14 will only be split if the number of entries exceeds 30. A coach may register additional entries for an event as "stand-bys". Coaches will be notified approximately 14 days before the tournament if space is available for any "stand-bys".

Coaches must complete a Team Registration packet for each team or unattached individual. A minimum number of 1 currently certified judge for every 4 competitors in both speed and freestyle must be provided by each team. Extra Speed judges would be most helpful. Please see attached forms for registration of athletes and judges.

**The competition will be administered according to the 2013 AAU Jump Rope rules.** All coaches and participants are urged to familiarize themselves with the AAU Handbook that contains the technical rules of competition. To obtain and download the 2013 AAU Jump Rope Handbook, please log on to [www.aausports.org](http://www.aausports.org) and click on Jump Rope.

The basic schedule will be as follows: Check in 8-8:30 a.m., Coaches/Judges Meeting 8:30 a.m., Events begin at 9 a.m. An exact schedule will be sent prior to the tournament.

Music is mandatory for the Individual Rope Singles and Pairs events, Double Dutch and for the Group Routine. It is the responsibility of each competitor, pair or team to present their music on a separate CD **that is playable on all standard audio systems.** A back-up CD should be available in the case of malfunction. A back-up CD consisting of all the music for that team is acceptable.

Commemorative medals will be presented to the top 3 All-Around winners in each event in each division. Pre-qualified or "Open" competitors from outside the USA will receive Sports For All Forever medals. Ribbons will be presented to the top 8 in each component event. Additionally, the top 10 US and Non-US place-winners in each combined event will qualify for the 2013 AAU Junior Olympic Games in Detroit, MI. In the event that a qualified participant cannot go to the AAU Junior Olympic Games, the next finisher will be offered the opportunity to go. It is therefore imperative that coaches notify me with registration if any of their competitors have already qualified elsewhere and as soon after this tournament as possible if their qualifiers do not intend to go to Detroit so that a slot may be offered to the next qualifying athlete.

Each Coach who has qualifiers for the AAU Junior Olympic Games who plan to compete **MUST** register the team and individual team members ON-LINE at [www.aaujrogames.org](http://www.aaujrogames.org). The handbook and hotel information will also be posted on-line.

- Events:** Singles – A Triple Crown event consisting of Speed (60 secs), Power (60 secs) and Freestyle to music (60-75 secs)  
Pairs – A Triple Crown event consisting of Pairs Speed (2x30 secs), Pairs Power (2x30 secs) and Pairs Freestyle to music (60-75 secs)  
Double Dutch – A Pentathlon event (4 People) consisting of Single Speed (60 secs), Single Power (60 secs), Single Freestyle (60-75 secs), Pairs Speed Relay (4x30 secs) and Pairs Freestyle (60-75 secs). Double Dutch Freestyle to music (60-75 secs)  
Junior and Senior Group Routine to music (2 to 4 minutes). 6 – 24 person event.
- Age-groups:** Individual Females: 8 and under, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13-14, 15-17, 18-22.  
Individual Males: 8 and under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-17, 18-22.  
Mixed or same gender in all other events:  
Pairs: 8 and under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-17, 18-22.  
Double Dutch: 12 and under, 13-14, 15-17, 18-22.  
Group Routines: 13 and under and 14-22  
Age is determined by the competitor's age on September 1, 2012.  
  
In multi-person events, age is determined by the age of the oldest competitor in the event.
- Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze for All Around winners in each event and age-group.  
1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> place ribbons for component events.

- All persons associated with the AAU Junior Olympic Games and its qualifying tournaments must adhere to the rules and guidelines outlined in the Amateur Athletic Union Official Code Book and the 2012 AAU Jump Rope Rulebook
- All participants agree to conduct themselves in a manner displaying good sportsmanship throughout the tournament. The Coach is responsible for seeing that team members, coaches, parents, representative judges and any other persons affiliated with their team conduct themselves accordingly. Ungentlemanly or unladylike conduct includes, but is not limited to: the use of obscene or profane language and gestures at the competition venue, or the doing of any act which tends to disrupt or obstruct a competition, or bring this Union or amateur athletics into disrepute. Severe cases of poor sportsmanship or conduct will result in disqualification.
- Any questions concerning the rules or procedures for the tournament will be handled exclusively by the designated coach of the team and must be directed to the Tournament Committee.
- Any interpretation of the tournament rules or any decision involving any aspect of the tournament will be rendered by the Tournament Committee. The Tournament Committee will render a judgment in an effort to insure that the tournament proceeds in a manner consistent with the general spirit and goals of the AAU.
- By participating in this tournament, each competitor and team representative agrees that the decisions made by the Tournament Committee will be final and will not be subject to review. Each competitor acknowledges the necessity for the judges to make prompt and fair decisions in this competition. Other than the process outlined in the 2012 Jump Rope Handbook, each competitor and coach waives any legal, equitable, administrative or procedural review of such decisions.
- Any competitor or team representative that does not adhere to the terms and procedures above may be disqualified from the tournament and automatically forfeits the right to any awards presented by the tournament. In addition, the competitor or team representative may also forfeit the opportunity to participate in any qualifying tournament and the AAU Junior Olympic Games tournament the following year.
