QUALIFICATIONS

A wrestler must be a current registered AAU member and attend school in the State of Missouri to be eligible to compete in the Missouri AAU State Wrestling Championships.

ADMISSION

Admission is \$5. Seven (7) and under are free.

AAU certified coaches must show their coaches card and photo I.D. for admission.

DIVISIONS

Gold Division: For wrestlers with less than one (1) year experience.

Blue Division: Open to any competitor meeting age requirement but is intended for wrestlers with more than one (1) year experience.

AGES & WEIGHTS

Gold division wrestlers will be **grouped** within the AAU mandated 12% allowance. Eight person brackets will be used in the Gold division whenever possible.

Blue division and High School wrestlers must weigh-in at their scheduled time and make their "scratch weight" with no weight allowance.

Wrestlers are required to weigh-in with a singlet and hair cover (if necessary). There will be no early or late weigh-ins and no changing weight classes. Please put exact weight for Blue division heavyweight wrestlers.
