

athlete's year of birth shall determine the age division in which he/she will compete for individual events. Relays will be run in 2 year age divisions:

- 8-Under, Born in 2005 or later
- 9 Years, Born in 2004
- 10 Years, Born in 2003
- 11 Years, Born in 2002
- 12 Years, Born in 2001
- 13 Years, Born in 2000
- 14 Years, Born in 1999
- 15-16 Years, Born 1997-98
- 17-18 Years, Born 1995-96, 1994 if Birthday after 8/3/13.

*Competitors should bring their own implements to be used at Meet.
