\*\*Pee Wee athletes who are not participating in the primary age group will compete in the pee wees 1K age group and will not advance to the AAU cross country Championships. It is a exhibition race.

The cross country race schedule will be posted the week of the meet and be available on meet day.

Depending on the numbers in the 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 age groups they will be ran the together and separated at the end of the race.

Intermediate Girls and Young Women will compete together then Intermediate Boys and Young Men will compete together. These age groups will be separated at the finish line for placement and awards. No athlete will be allowed to compete in a younger or older age group.

AWARDS: Medals will be given to the top 3 place finishers in each event. Ribbons will be given to 4th thru 8<sup>th</sup> place.

<u>ADVANCEMENT</u>: Individual qualification for the National Championship requires advancement through an AAU District Cross Country Championship meet. <u>ALL</u> athletes who participate in a District Championship Meet in each age division qualify for the National Championship Meet.

2014 AAU Cross Country National Championship will be held at Kansas University in Lawrence Kansas on Saturday, December 6<sup>th</sup>, 2014. More information will be posted on aauathletics.org as it become available.

<u>PROOF OF AGE:</u> Proof of age may be required at District, National Qualifier and National Championship events and must be provided whenever required and or challenged. These are the acceptable forms of verification; original birth certificates, notarized original birth certificate, US military Government ID card, valid passport (not expired) and a valid US driver's license.
