### QUALIFICATIONS

A wrestler must be a current registered AAU member and attend school in the State of Missouri to be eligible to compete in the Missouri AAU State Wrestling Championships.

### **DIVISIONS**

Gold Division: For wrestlers with less than one (1) year experience.

Blue Division: Open to any competitor meeting age requirement but is intended for wrestlers with more than one (1) year experience.

#### **AGES & WEIGHTS**

Gold Division: Wrestlers will be grouped within the AAU mandated 12% allowance. Eight man brackets will be used in the Gold division whenever possible. Gold wrestlers WILL weigh-in.

Blue Division: Wrestlers must weigh-in and make Scratch Weight with no weight allowance. Please provide exact weight for HWT entries.
